MAYOR OF CITY, NY | MUNICIPAL CEO | 2007 – 2013

Elected for three consecutive terms as Mayor and Municipal CEO, Head of Policy Setting Board of Trustees, and Board of Police Commissioners. Directed policy formation and governance of \$35M annual operating budget. Managed seven direct reports including Chief Administrative Officer, Treasurer, Legal Counsel, Court Justices, Chief of Police, Fire Chief, and over 200 indirect staff.

- **Led the landmark decision to become the first US municipality to implement Cumulative Voting (CV) as a consent decree remedy to a Voting Rights Act violation – and become first in NYS to utilize CV and Early Voting.** Formed a team with the foremost legal and academic Alternative Voting System experts to persuade a partisan local government board, the US Department of Justice, and the Honorable Stephen J. Robinson (2nd Circuit U.S. District Court). Combined remedy achieved historic election results, with the first Hispanic, first two African Americans, and first non-party affiliated candidates being elected to the Board of Trustees. Voter turnout increased over 15% through Early Voting. 95% of surveyed voters utilized new voting system features to elect preferred candidate(s).
- **Successfully formed and managed multiple teams of specialized attorneys and industry experts to draft alternate policy legislation for local government enactment in:** land use & zoning regulations, for-hire vehicle permitting, adult entertainment uses, cabaret & night club licensing, fire safety code enforcement; neighborhood revitalization.
- **Managed multiple attorney teams for litigation defense against lawsuit claims** in the following areas: employer workplace challenges, eminent domain/condemnation, property rights, Article 78, taxi industry reform, union challenges.
